

Gate and Stile Construction Course

This is a one day practical construction course on site. The day is split into two sessions;

AM Session: covers the following subjects;

1. Health and Safety (General and site safety), 2. Tool box talk (Covering the proper use of tools and tool maintenance), 3. Risk Assessments, 4. Construction of a 4 or five bar stile on site (undertaking construction techniques, British standards for countryside furniture)

PM Session: covers the following subjects;

1. Construction of a self closing wooden pedestrian gate (undertaking construction techniques, British standards for countryside furniture, least restrictive access (LRA)), 2. Types of gate furniture, 3. Types of gates (standard gate, kissing gate, box gate).

The afternoon session will be ended with a questions and answer session and course evaluation.
