

MAKING A COMPLAINT ABOUT MOTOR VEHICLES ON GREEN LANES

If you are caused alarm, distress or annoyance by motor vehicles (4x4s, trail bikes or quad bikes), which may have been driving without consideration for other legitimate users, and which may have been damaging the surface of the track, or driving in an aggressive and threatening manner, please report them to the local police force. It may be an idea to contact the relevant police force first, to find out the name of the officer who would normally deal with such matters. If you do this, your complaint is likely to be dealt with fairly quickly.

Please give the police as many details of the incident as possible (i.e. time, date, location, direction of travel, details of the vehicles – such as make, colour, registration number etc). If you can provide the police with a photograph, so much the better.

If the offending vehicles have no number plates, but you see them being loaded or unloaded onto or from another vehicle or a trailer behind it, please give the officer the details of the carrying or towing vehicle.

Finally, please ask the officer to take action under Section 59 of the Police Reform Act 2002.
