

## 20 Walks updates

### Walk 3 Lost waterways

Section 1 Beacall's Lane is to the left of the old prison (road sign covered up)

Section 5 'Follow the fence round to the right and look for a kissing gate on the left into a copse' (stile is now a kissing gate)

### Walk 7 From Parliament to Puritans

Section 1 Wicket gate is now a stile Section 2 'Cross the enclosed poultry field to a gate' (not a stile) Section 3 'Carry on alongside the brook and through a gate in the hedge...' (not a stile) 'The path skirts Hobsley Coppice, go over a stile, then rising gentle to another stile' (additional stile added) Section 6 'Cross the brook to a third field gate and keep fence on your right' (additional gate added) '...exit through side of gate to track.' (gate is overgrown)

Section 10 '...before reaching a stile giving access to the castle car park' (not a wicket gate)

### Walk 8 "God's Little Mountain"

Section 8 'Shortly after crossing the footbridge cross a bridge on the right

'At point 8 turn left onto the road then at the T junction turn left, then at the next junction turn right and re-join the route at the left-hand turn. As shown by blue arrows on map attached This is to avoid a very muddy section due to a cattle feeding station being positioned next to the footpath

### Walk 12 Historic bridges and celebrated snowdrops

Section 4 'Where the track appears to divide go straight on over the wooded bridge and continue up the path to the right of the wooded hut' (original footbridge no longer exists)

Section 7 'Go uphill at first then bear right and follow the fence to a gate into the wood...

' Section 8 'Go straight across the next field to go along a protruding hedge and go through a gap in the hedge in the corner to the right.' (stile no longer exists)

### Walk 16 A walk on the wild side

Section 2 'Walk straight ahead uphill between two oak trees to a stile'

Section 6 'Leave the Shropshire Way here and go through the kissing gate and to the right of the gate and next to a tree' (not a stile)

Section 8 'Go through two gates, enter an open field and continue slightly to the right to a kissing gate' (not a stile)

### Walk 19 A mere wander

Section 1 'At Hayes Farm, bear left away from the farm buildings and walk straight on to the centre of the field then turn right to go through a way marked gate.'

Section 2 'At the next gateway, turn left to follow the hedge round to a stile then right to keep the hedge on your right to a double stile with planks between.'

Section 3 'Turn right and continue along the road to a junction. Continue along the road towards Myddle.' 'Shortly after passing Fenemere Manor, go over a double stile on left. Follow field boundary to left into the next field bordered by two closely placed stiles.'

Section 4 ADVICE due to possible mud and blocked path – Turn left onto minor road then right on road towards Myddle. At first junction turn left to re-join route
